HENRY COUNTY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY

MEETING MINUTES

JUNE 4, 2020

I. CALL TO ORDER

A meeting of the Henry County Development Authority (HCDA) was held on June 4, 2020 at 125 Westridge Industrial Blvd., McDonough, Georgia. Board members present were Pierre Clements, David Linton and David Crow. Board members Reggie Sylvain and Eddie Ausband participated by conference call. Also in attendance were Rod Meadows, Legal Counsel, Josh Fenn, Executive Director, Leah Brown, Director of Established Industry and Marketing, Jamal Lewis, Project Manager and Terry Collins, Recording Secretary. At 8:05 a.m., Chairman Clements called the meeting to order.

II. CALL ROLL/QUORUM/NOTICE OF MEETING

Chairman Clements asked for a roll call, which indicated the presence of a quorum, and verified that meeting notices were properly executed and posted.

III. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Chairman Clements asked if there were any changes or addition to the agenda as presented. Hearing none, Mr. Linton made a motion to approve the agenda and Mr. Crow seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

IV. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Chairman Clements asked if there were any questions or comments regarding the Minutes of March 4, 2020, March 17, 2020 called meeting and April 20, 2020 called meeting. Hearing none, Mr. Crow made a motion to approve and Mr. Linton seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

V. STANDING REPORTS

INVOICES/FINANCIALS/CORPUS

Mr. Fenn reviewed the HCDA Consolidated Budget Report ending January 31, 2020 noting that the Authority is currently at 68.4% of County budget and 50.5% of Corpus budget. He noted that spending has been down due to COVID-19 with various events and conferences being cancelled. Mr. Fenn discussed that some future event registrations are being purchased at the early bird rate, however if they are cancelled, the Authority will be credited or refunded. With no further discussion, Mr. Linton made a motion to approve the Invoices, Financials and Corpus reports as presented. Mr. Ausband seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

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STAFF REPORT

Board members were provided with a May 2020 Marketing Report, a copy of which is attached to these minutes. Mr. Fenn reported that on June 8, 2020 he would be participating in a Henry County Stakeholders Forum Town Hall meeting along with the Henry County Schools Superintendent and Henry County Manager to discuss the upcoming school year. They hope to have information available as soon as possible to help residents plan for the new school year. Mr. Fenn noted that project activity is very good despite the challenges of the pandemic. He reported a 14% unemployment rate for April 2020 and that sales tax is down 3%. Mr. Fenn noted that these numbers do take time to come in so it is important to remain cautious economically.

As information, Mr. Fenn noted that the next regularly scheduled Authority Board meeting falls near the July 4, 2020 holiday. In the interest of today's time, he will poll Board members via email as to rescheduling the meeting or not. He also noted that there is a potential for a Called meeting before July and more information will be provided.

Mr. Fenn reviewed this week's announcement of the new Ferrero USA, Inc. distribution center in Henry County, and he anticipates more announcements very soon.

Ms. Brown reported that staff has increased efforts with established industry visits and that as a team, have done several rounds of visits, calls and surveys to Henry County established industries. Staff is trying to provide businesses with resources they may need to navigate issues due to COVID-19. She noted that social media, blog and email continue as staff moves forward with more ways to address the needs of established industry.

DISTRICT REPORTS

District 1 – no report

District 2 – Mr. Linton reported that District 2 Commissioner Clemmons did a great job at a forum last night and was complimentary of the HCDA.

VI. OLD BUSINESS

No Old Business was discussed.

VII. NEW BUSINESS

FY 2021 HCDA Corpus Budget

Mr. Fenn reviewed that the FY 2021 HCDA County budget has been approved. Board members were presented with a draft FY 2021 HCDA Corpus budget. Mr. Fenn noted that after discussion with Chairman Clements, he had added back the \$1,000 membership to Aerotropolis. Mr. Sylvain made a

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motion to approve the FY 2021 HCDA Corpus Budget as presented with the one addition as discussed. Mr. Linton seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Target Industry Study Update

Mr. Fenn discussed that efforts to include the four Cities in funding for the Target Industry Study update have been curbed by the COVID-19 pandemic and that he is hopeful to pick up the process in August. Mr. Fenn noted that the HCDA has been approached by Central Georgia EMC for a use for unclaimed capital credits and the possibility of funding a sector to expand target industry. Staff would like to accept a grant of \$20,000 from Central Georgia EMC to move forward with an update to the Target Industry Study done in 2011. Mr. Fenn reviewed a draft Request for Proposal (RFP) for a Target Industry Study Update and entertained questions from the Board. After discussion, Mr. Linton made a motion to adopt a resolution to move forward with the RFP for a Target Industry Study Update and for the Authority to accept the grant of \$20,000 from Central Georgia EMC to fund it. Mr. Crow seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

VIII. LEGAL MATTERS

Mr. Meadows reviewed the litigation matter between the Henry County Schools and the Henry County Board of Assessors. He noted the final analysis is that the Georgia Court of Appeals accepted Henry County Judge Brian Amero's ruling. The constitutional Freeport Exemption is valid and extends to goods in e-commerce. Mr. Meadows proposed to put the matter into a timeline to present to the Board at which time all Board members are physically present.

IX. EXECUTIVE SESSION

At 8:40 a.m., Mr. Linton made a motion to move to Executive Session for the purpose of Personnel. Mr. Crow seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

X. ADJOURN

At 9:00 a.m., Mr. Linton made a motion to adjourn and Mr. Crow seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
